

Prize “iDanae Chair” to the best TFM

Rules of the Prize

1. To be eligible for the Prize, all of the following conditions must be satisfied:
 - a. The Thesis corresponds to one of the following Masters:
 - Master's Degree in Computer Engineering
 - Master's Degree in Data Science
 - Master's Degree in Artificial Intelligence
 - Master's Degree in Software Engineering
 - Master of Science in Health & Medical Data Analytics (EIT Health)
 - Master's Programme in Digital Innovation: Data Science (EIT Digital Master School)
 - Master's Programme in Digital Innovation: Fintech (EIT Digital Master School)
 - b. The Master is studied during the academic year 2021-2022, and the Thesis is defended and graded before 1 August 2022.
 - c. The Thesis is related to the development of the Chair's activities: Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, applications of these fields to the business environment, the metatrends highlighted in the publications, or related to the Chair's lines of research.
2. The award process is as follows:
 - a. Submission of applications: until 30-July-2022
 - b. Presentation of the work: once defended
 - c. Award decision: September-2022
 - d. Awarding of the prize: during the Academic Act of Presentation of Diplomas, or in the act of presentation of works of the Chair in the Royal Academy of Sciences.
3. Submission of Applications
 - a. Interested students should apply for the award by email to the iDanae Chair, via the address catedra.idanae@upm.es, also available at the link on the Chair's web page <https://blogs.upm.es/catedra-idanae/>. The students can send the application from 1-February-2022.
 - b. In this application the following information should be included: name and surname, student registration number, e-mail address (essential), contact telephone number (mobile) and postal address, as well as the title of your Master's thesis (if already assigned).
 - c. It is recommended to include a description of the main contribution of the work and why this contribution is relevant. In addition, any additional noteworthy merits may be highlighted, such as publications or papers derived from it, real applications and/or

transfer of results to the company, etc. In the event that the student has registered before having this information, this information may be provided once the work is completed, and always before 30-July-2022.

- d. Once the TFM has been defended, the TFG will be sent at the request of the Chair.
4. Awarding of the prize: resolution phases
 - a. Phase I: The 5 best Theses will be selected. Priority will be given to those that have obtained or are eligible for “Graded with Honours”.
 - b. Phase II: students who have passed Phase I will visit Management Solutions' facilities and present their work to a panel of experts, including members of the Chair, who will assess the project as a whole: degree of alignment with the Chair's activities (30%), technological innovation (30%), application in the business world (30%) and presentation (10%). This panel of experts will determine which project wins the award.
 5. The prize is endowed with €2,000 in cash (gross of taxes) for the author of the winning Thesis.
 6. By submitting the application, the student agrees that the jury of the award (both from the School and Management Solutions) may access the work submitted for defence. The student also agrees that Management Solutions may contact the student, whether or not he/she is chosen as a finalist for the award.
 7. Submission of the award constitutes acceptance of the privacy policy (see next section below).

Identification and contact details of the person responsible

2. Necessary and up-to-date information

Likewise, by sending the data for participation in the prize, you declare that the information and data you have provided are accurate and truthful.

4. Detailed information on the treatments carried out by the Chair

Purpose of processing
To manage, process and contact the student for the awarding of the prize for the best TFM. Likewise, the purpose of the processing of your personal data is to manage personnel selection processes for the companies of the MS Group and the relationship as a candidate.
Legal basis
Legitimate interest of the Chair to analyse and decide on the awarding of the prize as well as the consent of the interested parties to be included in the selection processes and in the database of candidates of the companies of the MS Group.
Addressees
Your data may be transferred to companies of the GMS Management Solutions, S.L. Group, a company with registered office at Plaza Pablo Ruiz Picasso, 1, Torre Picasso, 28020, Madrid, Spain, with Tax Identification Code B-83509307 (the "Group"), as co-founder of the Chair together with the UPM, for the purpose of supporting the resolution of the award, as well as to contact the student for possible selection processes.
International transfers
Your data may be transferred to Group companies, some of which are located outside the European Union ("EU") and include those listed in the link below. These transfers would be made on the basis of the signature with such companies located outside the EU of standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission for international transfers.
Conservation period
Up to five years from receipt of your academic data.

5. Exercising your rights

We inform you that you may exercise the following rights:

- (i) the right of access to their personal data in order to know which personal data are being processed and the processing operations carried out on them;
- (ii) the right to rectify any inaccurate personal data;
- (iii) the right to erasure of their personal data, where possible;
- (iv) the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data where the accuracy, lawfulness or necessity of the processing is in doubt, in which case we may retain the data for the purpose of pursuing or defending claims;
- (v) the right to object to the processing of your personal data, where the lawful basis for us to process your personal data as set out in the table above is legitimate interest. For these purposes, we will stop processing your data unless we have a compelling legitimate interest or for the formulation, exercise or defence of claims.
- (vi) the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
