IN4SOC (Internships for enhancing Social and Civic Key Competences for Lifelong Learning in Technical Universities) was approved by the European Union in the Call for Proposal of the Erasmus+ 2018. The project started in September 2018 and it will have a total duration of three years.

The main objective of the IN4SOC project is to enhance the involvement of technical universities in the social responsibility of organizations, as a pedagogical approach that considers the acquisition of the key social and civic competence of students and strengthens the engagement of academia with the community.

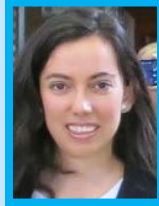

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## Intellectual output (IO) 7 is launched

September 2019

IN4SOC toolkit to implement SOC internships in Technical Universities.

IO7's main purpose is to create reference materials, in the form of a "toolkit" for any University or Organization wishing to be part of the IN4SOC network and deliver SOC internships.

This IO documents the SOC internships conducted through a monitoring protocol to be used by all partners to track the pilot SOC internships.

This intellectual output will run from September 2019 to August 2021.



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Steering Committee meeting

October 2019

The IN4SOC kick-off meeting was held on October 17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 in Miskolc, Hungary at Miskolci Egyetem (University of Miskolc)

The meeting covered relevant discussions on the guidelines to formulate SOC internships, the checklists to identify quality experiences, the guidance reports for a successful SOC, the rubric to evaluate students' performance and the management and monitoring of the internships.

The next consortium meeting will take place in Lisbon, Portugal on March 25 – 27, and will include a presentation to students at Universidade NOVA de Lisboa.

# IN4SOC Workshops for students and organizations

December 2019

Three workshops have been held to communicate the project to potential SOC interns.
